TCG Nordica's Responsibilities

1. To provide a performance stage with TCG Nordica's own sound equipment, music instruments (not including grand piano), lights and stage decorations

2. Sound and light management during rehearsal and performance. If the artist wishes to use his/her sound and light manager it will take place under the supervision of TCG Nordica Stage Manager.

3. Advertisement of the performance in TCG Nordica bi-monthly program (widely circulated) based on information provided by the artist. If TCG Nordica deems appropriate to promote

- 4 . The performance with posters, TCG Nordica will coordinate the designing, printing and posting advertisement posters. The actual cost of the designing and printing will be covered from ticket sales. The artist is responsible for providing needed texts and pictures for the poster.

- 5 . Coordinate English/Chinese translation of artist's background and performed pieces' information. The actual cost of the translation will be covered from ticket sales.

- 6 . Event management.

7 . Facility and equipment set up and clean up.

8 . Facility use (includes electricity, bathroom).

9 . Custodial and safety guard service during the performance.

10. Ticket-sales

a) TCG Nordica reserves the right to sell tickets to the stage performance. The price and number of tickets is set by TCG Nordica. The ticket sales income will be first applied to cover performance incurred expenses by TCG Nordica. These expenses include, but not exclusive:

- i. Program printing
- ii. Designing and printing advertisement posters
- iii. Translating performance information into English
- iv. Basic electricity, rent, staff time and management fees

The remaining profit received from ticket sales will be divided between TCG Nordica and the performing artist according to what TCG Nordica and the artist have agreed. TCG Nordica wants to encourage the artist and pledges to give the performing party a minimum income of 100RMB/performance

Artist's Responsibilities

1. Prepare for a high-quality performance as agreed with TCG Nordica.
2. Involve in the performance preparations in cooperation with TCG Nordica. TCG Nordica sees each performance as a co-operation between the artist/s and TCG Nordica. Good flow of communication between the two parties is essential. If the artist's participation in the preparations is not sufficient or timely, TCG Nordica reserves the right to cancel the performance.
3. Provide personal introduction information with publicity pictures and background information of the pieces performed for posters and programs printing and hosting the performance. If information and pictures received is not sufficient or is received too late, TCG Nordica will not be responsible for any damage occurred.
4. Cooperation with TCG Nordica on setting up a rehearsal time a minimum of three days before the performance. The artist needs to arrive on time for the rehearsal. Rescheduling of rehearsal time should be arranged with TCG Nordica at least one day before. If the artist does not keep the appointed rehearsal time, TCG Nordica staff time will be charged towards the ticket sales income.
5. Arriving two hours prior to the performance to do final sound check and personal preparation. If the artist does not arrive punctually to the performance, TCG Nordica reserves the right to cancel the performance.
6. If artist needs other music instruments and/or stage equipment (including costumes) than provided by TCG Nordica, he/she is responsible for renting the music instrument/stage equipment and covering the cost for the rent.

Performance Involving Minors

1. Supervision: In case the performers are minors (under 15 years old) they need to be supervised at all times by their guardian (parent, teacher or an adult authorized by the parent).
2. Rehearsal and performance supervision and guidance. A performing minor should be accompanied by his/her teacher. The teacher is responsible for preparing the minor during the rehearsal and performance.

Media

When TCG Nordica deems it appropriate to contact media, TCG Nordica and the artist should contact media prior to the performance to provide information about the performance and to extend invitation to the performance. The artist's personal and performance background information provided by the artist will be given to the media upon request. Free tickets will be provided for the media representatives attending the performance.

Commission

If the artist wishes to sell his/her art work such as recordings, films, books, etc. during the performance event, TCG Nordica will charge a 30% commission on the total sales.

Release of Liability

TCG Nordica is not liable for the artist's personal injury or damage happened during rehearsal and performance. TCG Nordica is also not responsible for cancellations and changes to any contracted

performance for reasons beyond control.

In Case of Damage

In case the artist causes damage to TCG Nordica's property during rehearsal or performance, the artist should report the damage to the Stage Manager. The artist is liable for covering the cost of the damage as negotiated with TCG Nordica.

Recording of Live Performance & Event

- TCG Nordica has the sole right of photography and live video recording during the performance.

In the event of hiring professional personnel to do any recordings, including still photos and live recording, a separate contract shall be negotiated. The cost and benefit of producing and distributing photos, recordings and videos will be shared by TCG Nordica and the artist according to such a negotiation.

Cancellation

In case the artist needs to cancel the performance for any reason, the processing fee will not be returned.

Breaking the Contract

The items above are protected by the law once signed by the two parties, if one party breaks the contract which results in a loss, the party causing the loss should pay the other party _____ RMB.
